UPDATED COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOLS EFFECTIVE JULY 26, 2021

SAN BERNARDINO, CA— San Bernardino Superior Court (SBSC) is updating its face covering requirement in light of the recent changes to the positive cases and death rates. Beginning on Monday, July 26, all court users – regardless of vaccination status – must wear a face covering at all times while inside any court location. Security personnel will turn away any person not following this procedure. SBSC continues to follow all state and <u>local public health</u> orders to ensure the health and safety of all court users, judicial officers and employees while balancing access to justice during the COVID-19 pandemic.

As a reminder, do not come into any court location if you have COVID-19, are unvaccinated and have been exposed to someone with COVID-19, feeling ill, or have been asked to quarantine by a healthcare professional.
